## CORRECTION LINE ROAD

This fall Hart Construction will be upgrading Correction Line Road (TWP RD 590) on the section 2 miles west of SH 827.

Construction on the section 2 miles east of SH 827 will begin when the West 2 miles are complete - weather dependant (This project may carry over until spring 2010).

The Road **will not** be closed, but expect delays when using this section of road.
