

**PUBLIC NOTICE
COUNTY OF THORHILD NO. 7
NOTICE FOR WRITTEN SUBMISSIONS PERTAINING
TO DEVELOPMENT PERMIT APPLICATION #1602**

In accordance with the County of Thorhild No. 7 Land Use Bylaw 989-98, Private Landfill Direct Control (DC-5) District, Waste Management of Canada Corporation has applied to the County of Thorhild No. 7 for a development permit to construct and operate a class II landfill. The proposed development will be located in the County of Thorhild No. 7 within the following quarter sections: Section 19; NW ¼ of Section 18 and S ½ of 20 Township 61 Range 20 West of the 4th Meridian (approximately 5 km south of the Hamlet of Newbrook).

The proposed landfill project includes a waste disposal area with a protective liner, a leachate management system, a surface water management system and a landfill gas management system. The development project will incorporate access and on-site roads, entrance infrastructure (weigh-scale, public waste drop-off area, public recycling area and office and shop buildings), screening structures, a soil stockpile area and security measures.

At the February 22, 2011 County Council meeting, Council passed Resolution 120-2011 to deem the Waste Management Development Permit Application #1602 as complete.

Council has passed Policy 1110 setting out the process to be followed regarding Development Permit #1602. Copies of Policy 1110 can be picked up at the County office or viewed on the County website www.thorhildcounty.com under The Community, Public Notices.

Affected landowners and interested person(s) may obtain a copy of Development Permit Application #1602 and/or Policy 1110 at a nominal charge from the Manager of Land Use & Taxes, Planning and Taxation Department at the County Administration Office.

Policy 1110 states written submissions are to deal with planning merits of Development Permit #1602. The deadline for written submissions is Tuesday, April 5, 2011, being twenty one (21) days after the second advertisement in the Redwater Review.

As a required part of the Written Submission:

- the name
- signature
- mailing address
- legal description of the property
- the nature of interest of the person preparing the submission, and
- who can be contacted for further information

is needed.
